

Criteria for the Award of FEF Scholarships

1. The fundamental decisive factor “Merit-cum-in-affordability” would be determined by the Principals of the recipients’ institutions.
2. Scholarships would be properly advertised in leading newspapers by FEF and invariably placed on the notice boards of all the recipient institutions.
3. The eligible candidates:
 - a) Should have scored at least 60% marks in the last attended examination.
 - b) Parents’/Guardians’ income should be equal to or less than Rs.15,000/- per month.
 - c) Of non-salaried persons, would submit income certificate obtained from concerned District Coordination Officer / District Revenue Officer, clearly showing amount of total monthly income from all sources.
 - d) Of deceased parents will submit the death certificate duly verified from hospital or gazette officer.
 - e) Should not be the recipients of any other scholarship. If they are, they would have to produce a written proof of withdrawal from the other scholarship.
 - f) Must be domiciled in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (settled areas only).
 - g) Should have studied in recognized / registered private / public sector institutions of Pakistan.
 - h) Must have applied on the prescribed Application form (Designed, printed and displayed on its website by FEF).
 - i) Should have submitted the application, complete in all respects, necessarily through the Principal of the respective institution (Applications submitted directly to FEF would not be entertained).
 - j) The applications must have been selected and endorsed by the Scholarship Committee, comprising of three senior faculty members of each nominating institution and a representative of FEF.
4. Application forms complete in all respects, duly recommended for the award of scholarships by the Principals of the concerned institution, would be forwarded to FEF.
5. The information submitted by the Principals/candidates would be randomly counterchecked by the Foundation before issuance of scholarships- cheques.
6. Appropriate quota in the Government colleges will be allocated for all districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
7. In case of a tie in merit, both competing students would be given scholarships.
8. No Principal of any Institute will have the authority to change the names of awardees, the amount of scholarships and the number of awardees.
9. Scholarship will be paid through cross cheques to the Principals of institutes who will be responsible for proper disbursement and audit.
10. The duration of the Scholarship will be in accordance with the length of the degree/course chosen by the student.
11. The renewal of the scholarship will be:
 - a) On the basis of good behavior and performance in subsequent years.
 - b) Linked with passing each subsequent examination with at least 60% marks and the communication of each result to FEF by the Principals of said institutions.
12. After approval of the scholarship scheme the required number of application forms will be circulated to educational institutions included in scholarship program of FEF.
13. Preferably FEF scholarship will be distributed equally among male and female students belonging to urban and rural areas.
14. The institutions included in FEF scholarship program will be asked to provide 20% concession to the students receiving FEF scholarships.
15. The Principals of institutions will give certificate of compliance of scholarship policy to FEF.
